1. To receive apologies for absence

  - 4.1. Appeal on 08/02159/APP (22 Greenway). The appeal process is underway and no further news has been received.

  - 4.3. Aylesbury Vale Local Development Framework. A response has been submitted by Cllr Moulding. The current timescales for the framework are a pre-hearing meeting in December, examination of the framework in Feb/Mar 2010 and adoption in September 2010.
